After your baby is born, the doctor and nursing staff will administer an examination, newborn screening and provide any initial vaccines.

Call our office prior to going home from the hospital to schedule your newborn's first appointment; we want to see your baby in 4-7 days for the first weight check. We hope this exciting event will be the start of a wonderful relationship with your whole family.
